UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

These proposals were passed at our last Enduro Committee meeting and have made publication in the FTR magazine. Pending approval, they will be added to our 2008-09 Rulebook. They read as such:

1) Add to chapter IV, section D, checking stations paragraph 1.

Start control-yellow and white flag

Don King moved to accept, Allen Pearce Seconded.

Motion passed – unanimous

2) Change to chapter IV, section C, course rules paragraph 4, sentence 2.

Original:

It shall give the key time for all Known Controls as well as the exact mileage and schedule in miles per hour between turns and direction of the turn.

Change to:

It shall give the key time for the start, key time for all Known and Start Controls, as well as the exact mileage and schedule in miles per hour between turns and the direction of the turn.

Don King made motion to Accept. Allan Pearce Seconded.

Motion Passed – Unanimous

3) Change to Chapter V, Section C, Scoring Paragraph 7

Original:

A rider shall be penalized one point for every minute late in arriving at a Known Control. There shall be no penalty for arriving early at a Known Control unless the rider is 15 minutes or more early: then the rider is disqualified.

Change to:

A rider shall be penalized one point for every minute late arriving at a Known or Start Control. A rider leaving a Known or Start Control before his scheduled departure time will be penalized 2 points for each minute he is early. There shall be no penalty for arriving early at a Known or Start Control unless the rider is 15 minutes or more early: then the rider is disqualified.

Don King made motion to Accept. Allan Pearce Seconded.

Motion Passed - Unanimous

4) Add this line to Chapter V, Section C, Scoring Paragraph 9

All issues regarding work run credits must be submitted no later than the first month after the race results are posted in the magazine, or the date specified in any specials mailing.

The paragraph would then read:

9. **Results must be posted at least one-half hour before they become official. Any scoring protests shall be filed at this time. An enduro must be protested within two weeks after the run if any rider wishes to do so. All issues regarding Worked Run credits must be submitted no later than the first month after the race results are posted in the magazine, or the date specified in any special mailing.**

Allan Pearce made motion to Accept. Debbie Broderick Seconded.

Motion Passed – 11 in Favor, 1 Opposed.

After initial discussion, more information is needed for a vote. The proposal was withdrawn.

2) Change to Chapter 5, Section C, Number 14

Original:

A team shall consist of not less than three riders nor more than five riders. Riders may compete on only one team. They must be entered as a team before the meet begins. The best three scores will be used to determine the winning team for that event. In case of a tie, the 4th and 5th place riders placing will be used to determine the team winner. If still tied after the 5th person, the raw scores of each team rider will be added and the lowest team total wins. A team competing for a year end award shall remain consistent in its members. An eight member roster must be registered with the Enduro Scorekeeper. A minimum of any three, or a maximum of any five of these members, may enter an event. A team roster can only be changed in the event that the member(s) being deleted from the team is unable to compete in 3 or more of the remaining events for the season. Roster changes must be submitted in writing to the Enduro Scorekeeper.

Change to:

A team shall consist of not less than three riders nor more than five riders. Riders may compete on only one team. They must be entered as a team before the meet begins. The best three scores will be used to determine the winning team for that event. In case of a tie, the 4th **place riders placing will be used. If still tied, then** 5th place riders placing will be used to determine the team winner. If still tied after the 5th person, the raw scores of each team rider will be added and the lowest team total wins. A team competing for a year end award shall remain consistent in its members. An eight member roster must be registered with the Enduro Scorekeeper. A minimum of any three, or a maximum of any five of these members, may enter an event.
