FREE TRAIL RIDING !

Bring your ATV, motorcycle, or side-by-side and get a free three day pass to ride the Ocala National Forest trails! Make new OHV friends and camp for FREE at the Ocala OHV Operations Center!

Here's all you need to do:

If you live in the central or northeast Florida area, we need your help in taking care of the OHV trail system. We ask that you only give us your day on Saturday, May 1, 2010. You'll be helping us trim and groom our OHV trails near the Delancy area in the north part of the forest. We'll be starting from the OHV Operations Center located on Forest Road 11 (old 88) at 8:30 AM that morning.

For all those who participate in the work party on Saturday, you can ride for free on Sunday May 2nd. We'll even give you a *free three day pass* for the next time you want to come riding.

We'll have some tools but we ask that if you have hand pruners or loping shears – please bring them. We'll be pruning sections of trail that need it. We'll also be working on clearing some of the trails sharp corners - for safety reasons.

We welcome you to camp overnight in the field adjacent to the OHV Operations Center. You can bring your tent, RV, or trailer (no hook-ups provided) and camp in the field under the stars. Forest Service representatives will be on hand to talk about how we can work together to make our trails better.
