A proposal was submitted to require Mandatory spark arrestors for fire safety and reduction of sound.

1. **All Quads are required to have a spark arrestor. Spark arrestor testing will be done at the starting line with a rod test.**
2. An operating tether cord/switch, attached to the rider will be required for all competition Quads.
3. Quads must not exceed 50 inches in width.
4. Quads must display number plates, with the rider's number on the front and rear of the Quad.
5. From a dead engine start, Quad racers will be positioned on their Quads with both hands on top of their helmet. At the starter's signal, they will start their Quads and ride.

Brian motioned that we accept the proposal as written to be submitted to the magazine for the General membership to view. Wanda seconded, Unanimous approved. The proposal passed.

A proposal was submitted to change the referencing in the rulebook regarding promotional points in the QS.

Promotional points standards are currently indicated with a reference to the HS section of the rule book. It starts with an incorrect page number, which will constantly be changing with the rules each season. Furthermore, advancement points regarding the Quad Series may differ in the future from Hare Scrambles. It is proposed to place a copy of the Rider Advancement Rules in the QS portion of the Rulebook. The proposal is as follows:

<p>1. This system will award Advancement Points based on the rider's performance in their class. Advancement Points will be awarded as follows:</p> <p>1st place 10 Advancement Points 2nd place 5 Advancement Points 3rd place 4 Advancement Points 4th place 3 Advancement Points 5th place 2 Advancement Points</p> <p>The only exception to the above would be a case where 5 or fewer riders compete in a class at an event, then the advancement points shall be awarded as follows:</p> <p>1st place 5 Advancement Points 2nd place 3 Advancement Points 3rd place 2 Advancement Points 4th place 1 Advancement Points 5th place 0 Advancement Points</p> <p>2. When a total of forty-five (45) advancement points are accrued, the rider is promoted to the next higher division. When the points are accrued at or prior to the first fifty percent (50%) of the proposed and approved season sanctions, the rider is promoted immediately and will then take 90% of the points awarded in the lower class to the higher class. When the points are accrued after 50% or more of the scheduled events have been completed, the rider can remain in the lower class for the remainder of the season. The promotion will take effect at the start of the next competition season. However, riders voluntarily advancing themselves to a higher division after 50% of the scheduled events have been completed will carry no points to the higher division. Points earned in the lower division will remain in the lower division.</p>	<p>3. Advancement points will be carried only for the rider's previous ten events. The personal ten (10) events will carry from the previous years first race. This system will advance riders based on present performance, not an accumulation of past performances.</p> <p>4. If a new FTR member completely dominates a class, the Hare Scrambles Committee, through majority vote, may elect to advance the rider to the next higher class regardless of advancement points accrued. In addition, any rider can be advanced at any time by a unanimous vote of the Hare Scrambles Chairman, Referee, and Scorekeeper if it can be shown by use of lap and overall times that the rider is capable of finishing in the top 1/2 of the next higher division and the rider has finished at least 3 events in the lower division.</p> <p>5. The Hare Scrambles Committee reserves the right to adjust or refine the Advancement Points System, by majority vote, as the need arises.</p> <p>6. Any rider who Overall High Points a race will be promoted to the AA class effective at the next race.</p> <p>7. Beginner class riders will advance to the next higher division after accumulation of one 1st place, 3 top 5 finishes, or 8 starts. This promotion will take effect immediately. The beginner rider will carry 50% of their accumulated points into the C division and no points to any other division. The Beginner classes will receive no year-end awards.</p> <p>8. Peewee C riders will advance to the next higher class after accumulation of two 1st place finishes or 4 top 5 finishes. This promotion will take effect immediately. The rider will take 90% of their points awarded in the lower class to the higher class. Exception: If 90% of their points places them in a higher position in the new class they will be awarded only enough points to attain an equal position in the new class.</p>

A proposal was submitted to require the Pee Wee, Super Pee Wee , Youth, Mini, and Junior classes to have a matching frame and case combination. The purpose of this proposed rule change is to ensure the safety and fairness to all riders in their respective classes. The FTR Motocross Series as well as other off-road racing venues currently have this rule in effect for their youth quad classes.

Michael Head motioned that we accept the proposal as written to be submitted to the magazine for the general membership to view. Randy seconded, the proposal passed unanimously.

A proposal was submitted to include the Super Peewee classes in using a running engine start along with the Peewee's. Currently the Super Peewee class runs a dead engine start, and it has been very difficult for the riders that have a kick or pull start quad. This rule change would eliminate the need for rider assistance at the start of the race.

A proposal was submitted to divide the Super Peewee class into A and B divisions. The Super Pee Wee class ranges from 6-11 years and 51-90 cc's. There is currently a rapid increase of riders in this class, as many as 13 as of the third race of this season vs. two last season. If this growth trend continues throughout this season and next, safety becomes a concern. It should also be noted that the age group of these riders as well as the cc levels is quite broad, as is rider ability within this particular class.
