

Hare Scramble Committee Meeting 12/03/2016

Roll call 18 members present

Old business

Second vote on rule change Presented by Bill Toreki

This motion was intended to clarify an existing rule pertaining to riding multiple classes in one weekend.

Existing reads

3. A rider may ride one division or class per day, except #10 below. If they elect to move to another division, they must stay

in the higher division and not return to the lower division

without written request to and approval by the Hare Scrambles

Committee. The division that the rider rides first (if the rider

decides to change divisions on race day) will be the one that

points will be kept on for that race. This is the lower-ranking of

the divisions. After the race, they will be scored in the higher

division. They will take up to 90% of the earned lower division

points with them.

PROPOSED:

Hare Scramble Rules, Chapter VII, Section A-3 (page 24):

3a. A rider may only ride one class per day, except #10 below.

3b. If a youth rider elects to compete in a higher class during the season (i.e. Pee-Wee to 65, 65 to Mini, Mini to Junior, or Junior to Sunday) they must stay in the higher class, and not return to the lower class, without written request to and approval by the Hare Scrambles Committee. Points earned will not transfer between classes.

3c. A rider may not compete on both Saturday and Sunday at the same Meet (weekend), unless the Saturday class is Evo, Vintage, Pre-modern, or Quad (except Quad Junior), except as noted in section 3d, below.

3d. A Mini or Junior rider may compete in both a Saturday and Sunday class at the same meet (weekend) one time; however, they will no longer be eligible for the Saturday class at future meets (see 3b, above). The rider may receive season points in each class.

After discussion it was decided to eliminate 3b and accept the revised proposal to read as below.

3a. A rider may only ride one class per day, except #10 below.

3b. A rider may not compete on both Saturday and Sunday at the same Meet (weekend), unless the Saturday class is Evo, Vintage, Pre-modern, or Quad (except Quad Junior), except as noted in section 3d, below.

3c. A Mini or Junior rider may compete in both a Saturday and Sunday class at the same meet (weekend) one time; however, they will no longer be eligible for the Saturday class at future meets (see 3b, above). The rider may receive season points in each class

Re: Adding new Quad Silver Master Class

Presently the hare scrambles quad master category is growing and has a diverse number of riders that regularly participate. These riders are aging and have a varied level of skill, stamina, and talents. Thankfully the advances in health care appear to be working and riders are staying active much longer than previous generations.

Beyond this revelation there is also a contingency of very competitive racers who are age eligible for the present quad master's class and or close to age eligible for the quad master's class. With these riders potentially coming to the class it has the propensity to grow into a heavily populated class with a vast differential of age, skills, and talents.

I am requesting the new class / category be established to give all race the opportunity to continue racing in a fair and competitive category. This addition would give all riders a reasonable and fair opportunity to race and enjoy successful results while racing with riders of similar age, talent levels and abilities. This class addition offers senior age quad racers a similar system of class offerings and progressions that are currently afforded to other senior level groups within FTR.

I am requesting changes / amendments / additions to the rule(s) presently listed in the 2016 - 2017 FTR rule book.

I propose adding a new Quad Silver Master Class 55* to the hare scrambles, quad category.

- Displacement 0 – open cc,
- Plate color, Silver with Black numbers no letters,
- Race 8, Row 9, Saturday 3:45 -5:15pm race

- Page 12, section D, Rider's Classification, left and right side columns in hare scrambles categories.
- Page 15 # 6. Equipment, Vehicle displacement classes are as follows: Lower left column through right upper column down to mid page
- Page 23 # 8. Saturday Race Schedule, right column, mid to lower portion of page
- Page 27 and 28 Classes, number plate colors, letters, and number colors, this begins on page 27 right column mid-point down and continues on page 28 left upper column to mid-point
- Page 33, Hare Scrambles Number Plate requirements in the 2016 – 2017 FTR Rule Book.
